I write in connection with your request concerning Wiltshire-specific figures from the Crime Survey for England and Wales in 2025.

I am required by the Freedom of Information Act 2000 to handle all requests in a manner that is blind as to the identity and motives of the requestor. Any information released as a response to a request is regarded as being published and therefore in the public domain without caveat.

Following receipt of your request, research was conducted by the Office of Police Crime and Commissioner.

You wrote:

Please provide:

1. The source of these Wiltshire-specific figures (ONS bespoke tabulation, PCC analysis, or other).
2. The sample size and margins of error for Wiltshire respondents.
3. The Wiltshire-specific results (with sample sizes and confidence intervals) for all indicators in the ONS release, including:
 - Overall confidence in local police
 - Police visibility (weekly patrols)
 - Victim satisfaction with police response
 - Confidence that the CJS is effective
 - Agreement that the system is fair
 - Awareness of the Victims' Code
 - Trust statements (reliability, fairness, respect, understanding of concerns).
 - If not intended for publication, please confirm why Wiltshire figures are being used in public communications without methodology or caveats.
