### **PURPOSE OF REPORT**

1. This paper requests the PCC invest in a Mobile Policing Application approving the necessary budget securing the new platform via Avon and Somerset Police.

### **BACKGROUND**

2. Wiltshire Police has worked with Airpoint Ltd and its successors since 2014 to deliver a mobile policing application to frontline staff through Vodafone (UK) Ltd acting as prime contractor. The Airpoint application has delivered capability to the frontline, but progress has been slow and as a result we have not fully realised the expected benefits from the investment in a timely manner.
3. Following wider commercial events at Airpoint Ltd, unrelated to our contractual relationship via Vodafone (UK) Ltd, the company entered liquidation in March 2020. Subsequently the prime contractor entered into new contractual arrangements with another Airpoint Ltd group company Airpoint International Ltd.
4. While services have continued at present the rate of application change has slowed with several forces changing or about to change application provider. This has resulted in the prime contractor seeking to reduce their exposure to the supplier. The long-term viability of the current product is therefore a high risk, to facilitate this a planned replacement of the product is included in the Medium Term Financial Strategy (MTFS) and alternative solutions being considered.

### **THE MARKET PLACE**

5. Working with the South West Procurement Department (SWPPD) we have identified the following providers and number of forces they provide;
  - Pronto 17
  - Airpoint 5
  - Black Marble 4
  - HCL 6
  - In House solutions 11
6. Motorola's Pronto application is now the UK market leader in mobile policing applications. Pronto is used by Devon and Cornwall and Gloucestershire. Dorset are currently on-boarding to Pronto from Airpoint.
