I write in connection with your request for information dated 5 September 2014 concerning the amount paid by Wiltshire Police to the Confederation of British Industry and its regional subsidiaries between 2009 and 2014. I am replying on behalf of both the Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner for Wiltshire and Swindon and the Chief Constable of Wiltshire Police.
