I write in connection with your request for information dated 10th December 2014 concerning disposal of police property.

I am required by the Freedom of Information Act 2000 to handle all requests in a manner that is blind as to the identity and motives of the requester. Any information released as a response to a request is regarded as being published and therefore in the public domain without caveat.

Following receipt of your request, searches were conducted within the Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner (OPCC). I can confirm that the information you have requested is held by the Police and Crime Commissioner.

Your request has now been considered and it is not possible to meet your requirements in full.

You wrote:

Can you supply a breakdown of the police properties disposed of over the past five years The amounts raised Where did the proceeds go? Any pending currently on offer and at what price?

Response

Below are the police properties have been disposed of in the last five years and the price obtained:

105 Avonmead Swindon - £165,000

27 Christie Miller Road Salisbury - £225,000

Unit 4 Prince Maurice Court Devizes - £170,000

Mere Down Radio Mast - £34,000

Part of Salisbury Police Station site - £2 million

Corsham Police Station - £562,000.

The proceeds of sale on buildings go into the police reserves which are used to fund future projects.

Chippenham Police Station is the only property currently on the market and will be sold for the best price that can reasonably be obtained.

I am satisfied that all the relevant information has been passed to me, and been considered in the light of your request, within the time constraints applicable under the legislation.
