I write in connection with your request for information dated 10<sup>th</sup> August 2015 concerning payments made to the Confederation of British Industry and its subsidiaries.

I am required by the Freedom of Information Act 2000 to handle all requests in a manner that is blind as to the identity and motives of the requestor. Any information released as a response to a request is regarded as being published and therefore in the public domain without caveat.

I am responding to your request on behalf of the Wiltshire Police and the Police and Crime Commissioner as we share a finance service.

Your request for information has now been considered and I am able to respond as follows:

You wrote:

I am writing to obtain information about the amount your organisation pays to the Confederation of British Industry and its subsidiaries. Please provide the amount paid to the CBI (and its regional subsidiaries)

- (a) in membership fees
- (b) fees for one off conferences or other events and
- (c) fees paid to the CBI for any other services.

Please make clear if the response includes payments from any Non-Departmental Public Bodies, Executive Agencies etc which fall under the department and please provide a breakdown of what payments came from which agency/body.

Please provide this information for the period 2009-2015 set out by calendar or financial year.

Response

There have been no payments made to the Confederation of British Industries or its subsidiaries by the Police and Crime Commissioner for Wiltshire or by Wiltshire Police for the period of 2009-2015.
