I write in connection with your request for information dated 14 March 2019 concerning the office costs of the Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner.

The total cost of running the OPCC for 2018-19 is set to be £815,291

This includes all staffing costs to support the PCC, commissioning of services and administration costs.
